<p>Purpose of sth ——— for + ing</p>	<p>eg. This knife is for cutting bread, that one is for slicing meat.</p>
<p>Giving reasons</p> <div> <p>For + a noun</p> <p>For + ing</p> </div> <p>Verbs like "Thank, apologise, be/feel sorry..."</p> <p>Expressions like "criticised for, fined for, rewarded for..."</p>	<p>eg. Thank you for the lift</p> <p>Thanks <u>for driving</u> me home</p> <p>Apologise <u>for spitting</u> in his face.</p> <p>Sorry <u>for taking</u> so long wih this report.</p>
